


**ASSETS:** If you have completed Driver's Ed with Assets AND you have your permit, please stop by 302 to sign up for behind the wheel driver's training.


High Schoolers! Do you need help with homework or tutoring, come to room 307 every Tuesday-Friday at 3:30, snack and transportation is provided.


Driver's ed is still free in ASSETs for all 15 -17 year old. Come by 302 Wednesdays 3:30-4:30 to sign up or check in!
